If you were in paid employment or self-employed before becoming unemployed, please provide the following documents:

Your latest wage statement or other certificate showing your weekly working hours and pay over a period of at least 26 weeks (about 6.5 months) as well as any end-of-service compensations.

As an employee, you satisfy the condition regarding the terms of employment if, during the previous 28 months, you have been employed for 26 calendar weeks and working at least 18 hours per week. Your pay must be in accordance with the applicable collective agreement or at least €1,189 per month (in 2018). However, if you have a wage-subsidised job, only 75% of the calendar weeks in which the work requirement is fulfilled counts towards the work requirement.

If you have been self-employed, Kela will ask you for documentation once your claim is being processed.

You satisfy the condition regarding the terms of employment if you have been self-employed for 15 months or more during the previous 48 months. All periods of self-employment lasting at least 4 months in which total earnings under the YEL (self-employed persons) and MYEL (farmers) pensions acts and earnings under the TyEL (employees) pensions act earned as a self-employed person come to at least €1,048 per month (in 2018) count towards the condition.

The 24/48-month reference period can be extended for a maximum of 7 years for such reasons as studying, performing military service or caring for a child under the age of 3 years.

Copy of an application for pay security or decision if you have applied for compensation for unpaid wages under the pay security scheme.

Documentation showing the wage or salary and the working hours.

Proof of copyright royalties received in the current or previous year.

Proof of income received from self-employment.

If you have rental income, include not only the rental agreement or receipt but also proof of payment for any landlord expenses such as heating, water or maintenance charge.

For interest on deposits, proof is needed only if the amount deposited exceeds €2,000.

You can earn up to €300 per month or €279 per 4 weeks without it affecting your unemployment benefit.
